- Expertise in organic chemistry, physical metallurgy, biology, microbiology, molecular biology, genetics, population genetics, proteomics, bioinformatics or related field
- Demonstrated research excellence
- Peer reviewed publication of research results
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, interpersonal, organizational, and analytical skills
- Ability to lead research of technicians and research assistants
- Enthusiasm for learning and applying knowledge to industry challenges
