According to Health Canada, radon exposure is responsible for about 16% of lung cancer deaths in Canada¹. Even if you are a non-smoker, you can still develop lung cancer from breathing in radon over a long period of time.

The amount of radon in your home depends on many factors such as your foundation, soil/rock below your home, ventilation, weather, and the season. You cannot estimate your radon level based on how old, large, where your home is located, or what your neighbour's radon level is.

RADON TESTING IS EASY AND AFFORDABLE!



Radon test kits are very cost effective and are available online. The RPC Alpha Track Radon Detector test kit consists of a small device that you place in the lowest occupied level of your home. You leave it there for at least three months, then send it to the RPC laboratory for analysis.

RADON REDUCTION IS POSSIBLE AND EFFECTIVE.



If your radon level is above the Canadian guideline of 200 Bq/m³, you should take action to lower it. There are proven methods to reduce radon in your home, such as installing a radon mitigation system that vents the gas outside. A certified radon professional can help you choose the best option for your situation and budget.
