

Highlights of 2014-2015

October 16, 2015, Fredericton, NB - The 2014-2015 year saw New Brunswick's Provincial Research Organization (PRO) achieve a number of milestones. Sales revenue for the year surpassed \$10 million while RPC served 1000 clients. RPC is growing both its capabilities and its capacity and invested \$1 million in capital improvements during 2014-2015. RPC continues to be a key business resource for market-driven research and technical services with 80% of revenue sourced from industry.

"We are very pleased with our performance", remarked Eric Cook, Executive Director and CEO. "Most impressive is that 100% of clients surveyed would use our services again. This is a testament to the fantastic service our employees provide."

RPC has a staff of 94 highly qualified personnel working from its main facilities in Fredericton and a lab in Moncton. New Brunswick created its PRO in 1962 making 2014-2015 its 53rd year of operation. Highlights of the year are depicted in the attached infographic.
