

## **RPC Releases 2018-2019 Annual Report**

October 31, 2019, Fredericton, NB - RPC has released its 2018-2019 Annual Report highlighting significant achievements over the past year. As New Brunswick's Research and Technology Organization (RTO) our mission is to serve the science needs of industry and government. We accomplish this by providing analytical and applied research services for a fee. Our sales revenue is an indicator of the demand for our services and therefore our success. During the past year, our operating revenue was up 25% to a record \$16.6 million. The increased demand resulted in 25 direct hires at RPC. Most significantly, RPC contributed to the success of over 1000 clients.

During the year RPC launched a new advanced manufacturing adoption program, completed numerous renovations and upgrades, and initiated a major information technology renewal project.
